In January 2023, the newly elected Council members and the plenary speakers from the 2023 Congress who were active EEA members became Fellows.



Membership

The previous report of the EEA Executive Vice-President (2022) gave membership as around **3850** (with **13** institutional members having paid at the time of the report). When we closed the year, we had received payment from **16** institutional members.

Individual Membership income generated €215,901.91 (up by €18,93414 on 2021 figures) in 2022 while Institutional Membership brought in an extra €134,805.87 (figures taken from the end of year accounts).

The latest figures (at time of writing this report) available suggest that individual membership now stands at just **under 3800** (with membership, in line with increase in submissions for the EEA 2022 congress.

Financial Position of EEA as of December 2022

Detailed EEA 2022 Accounts are available upon request. I report that the result to be carried forward has decreased from €2,509,064.25 to €2,354,434.64.

The **loss** of **€154,629.61** equals the difference between income of €1,144,416,44 and expenses of €989,786.83.

Of these losses, €140,449.60 was due to a drop in EEA's investment portfolio. The operating losses. include, but are not limited to, the expenses and income involved in Oxford University Press JEEA production, heavily subsidizing student / low-middle income registration fee for the 2022 EEA-ESEM congress.

We are particularly grateful to our institutional members whose donations continue to provide a vital source of income.

The EEA Audit committee – Ricardo Reis (Chair), Jordi Gali and Davide Cantoni - have viewed the accounts. In their opinion they present fairly the financial position of the EEA as of December 31, 2022. Their report will be made, with final comments, will be made available from September 1. We thank the Committee for their work.



Writing EEA's Statutes

Due to a change in the "Code on Companies and Associations Act" in Belgium, all non-profits have to rewrite their statutes by the end of 2023.

The EEA plans to introduce an administrative board / board of directors consisting of 3-5 members who would have legal responsibility over the Association (currently all 36 Council members are classed as administrators, and it makes a number of issues very difficult to deal with.

The EEA members will receive the proposed statutes in an email around mid-September and will be asked to vote on it.



Future 12 months

The EEA will spend the coming 12 months consolidating the coordination of a centralized virtual job market and strengthening the activities of its Standing Committees – Education, Minorities, Research and Women.
