Fellowship

In January 2024, the newly elected Council members and the plenary speakers from the 2023 Congress who were active EEA members became Fellows.



Membership

The previous report of the EEA Executive Vice-President declared that membership at the time of the congress (August 2023) was just under 3800. When we closed the year, we had received payment from 16 institutional members.

Individual Membership income generated €239,086 (up by €23,184.09 on 2022 figures) in 2023 while Institutional Membership brought in an extra €145,489.15 (figures taken from the end of year accounts).

The latest figures (at time of writing this report) available suggest that individual membership now stands at just just over 3430 (in line with decrease in submissions for the EEA 2024 congress.

Financial Position of EEA as of December 2023

Detailed EEA 2023 Accounts are available upon request. I report that the positive result to be carried forward has increased from €2,354,434.64 to €2,504,500.64. The surplus of €150,066 equals the difference between income of €1,304,085.31 and expenses of €1,154,019.31. These include, but are not limited to, the expenses and income involved in Oxford University Press JEEA production, whose costs increased in 2023 due to increasing the compensation of JEEA Editors and its staff by 50% (as it has not been increased since 2003). €106,057.23 was due to an increase in EEA's investment portfolio. We are particularly grateful to our institutional members whose donations continue to provide a vital source of income.

The EEA Audit committee – Ricardo Reis (Chair), Jordi Gali and Davide Cantoni - will view the accounts. Their report will be made, with final comments, will be made available in July. We thank the Committee for their work.

EEA's Approved Statutes 1/3

Confirming EEA's New Statutes

The European Economic Association has had to update its statutes to comply with the Belgian Code on Companies and Associations (the "BCCA"), enacted by the Belgian parliament in early 2019. The BCCA aims at modernising and simplifying company / association law and offers more flexibility to Belgian companies / associations, but it requires us to amend our articles of association and bring them in line with the provisions of the BCCA. The EEA members were asked to vote by e-ballot and the statutes have been approved with 233 members approving them and 3 members not.



EEA's Approved Statutes 2/3

Approving EEA Administrative Board and Directors

According to our new statutes, the EEA has an **administrative board** / board of directors consisting of 3-5 members who have legal responsibility over the Association.

We propose the nomination of the EEA Presidents, Executive Vice-President and EEA Executive Manager to sit on this board.

From 2024 to 2025, this would **be Jan Eeckhout, Hélène Rey, Imran Rasul, Antonio Cabrales and Gemma Prunner-Thomas**.

We officially retire all other administrators who appear on the current CBE.



EEA's Approved Statutes 3/3

Renaming of Council

According to our new statutes, the EEA has renamed the Council to a Scientific Council.

We ask EEA members to confirm the reappointment of all the current members of Executive Committee and Council on the Scientific Council with their current terms in office.



Future 12 months

The EEA will spend the coming 12 months consolidating the coordination of a centralized virtual job market and strengthening the activities of its Standing Committees – Education, Minorities, Research and Women.
